

Worship Team Job Descriptions

1. Worship Leader:

- a. Spiritual – Mature believer; Humble, Christ-centered; understands the nature of worship; models the Christian walk well**
- b. Musical – Semi-literate; Good musician/vocalist; can arrange songs as needed; able to construct a service**
- c. Personal – Confident; Able to lead; Leads musicians well; team builder**

2. Vocalist:

- a. Spiritual – Believer; Humble, Christ-centered, in fellowship**
- b. Musical – Able to carry a tune well, good range, sings to the best of his/her ability; sings with confidence; in sync with team, listens to others**
- c. Personal – Able to follow; willing to take direction; willing to make constructive comments about songs/arrangements; on time, prepared, practiced**

3. Instrumentalist:

- a. Spiritual – Believer; Humble, Christ-centered, in fellowship**
- b. Musical – Plays well, steady, team player - in sync with team & listens to others, blends into the sound of the team; plays with confidence**
- c. Personal – Able to follow; willing to take direction; willing to make constructive comments about songs/arrangements; on time, prepared, practiced**

4. Sound Booth Operator:

- a. Spiritual – Believer; Humble, Christ-centered, in fellowship**
- b. Technical – Skilled in working with the board; have a good ear for mixing a live sound; willing to take direction from the worship leader; ‘team player’**
- c. Personal – Able to take criticism, on time, attend practices (when needed)**

5. PowerPoint Operator:

- a. Spiritual – Believer; Humble, Christ-centered, in fellowship**
- b. Technical – Skilled in working with the PowerPoint program and the computer; have a good sense of the songs to facilitate a smooth show on Sundays, willing to take direction from the worship leader; ‘team player’**
- c. Personal – Able to take criticism, on time, attend practices (when needed)**
