Theme Night	Explanation
AWANA Awards Night	Night to honor the clubbers for all their hard work throughout the year.
Backward Night	Clubbers and Leaders Dress Backwards, Games are run backwards, etc
Be Creative/Art Night	Clubbers bring something they made/drew/painted etc. Suggested topic for council time could be God's creativity.
Bring a Toy Night	Clubbers bring a toy they no longer use to donate to children at La Casa domestic violence shelter.

Missions Night - bring your parents too	All Church Missions Night.
