⁷ In him we have redemption through his blood, the forgiveness of our trespasses, according to the riches of his grace, *Ephesians 1:7 (ESV)*

I am predestined for an inheritance.

¹⁰ as a plan for the fullness of time, to unite all things in him, things in heaven and things on earth. ¹¹ In him we have obtained an inheritance, having been predestined according to the purpose of him who works all things according to the counsel of his will, *Ephesians 1:10-11 (ESV)*

I have been sealed by the Holy Spirit.

¹³ In him you also, when you heard the word of truth, the gospel of your salvation, and believed in him, were sealed with the promised Holy Spirit, *Ephesians 1:13 (ESV)*

I have been made alive in Christ.

⁴ But God, being rich in mercy, because of the great love with which he loved us, ⁵ even when we were dead in our trespasses, made us alive together with Christ— by grace you have been saved— *Ephesians 2:4-5 (ESV)*

I am seated in the heavenly places...

⁶ and raised us up with him and seated us with him in the heavenly places in Christ Jesus, *Ephesians 2:6 (ESV)*

I have been created for good works.

¹⁰ For we are his workmanship, created in Christ Jesus for good works, which God

prepared beforehand, that we should walk in them. *Ephesians 2:10 (ESV)*

I am a member of Christ's body.

⁶ This mystery is that the Gentiles are fellow heirs, members of the same body, and partakers of the promise in Christ Jesus through the gospel. *Ephesians 3:6 (ESV)*

I have access to God in Christ.

¹² in whom we have boldness and access with confidence through our faith in him. *Ephesians 3:12 (ESV)*

I am a citizen of heaven.

²⁰ But our citizenship is in heaven, and from it we await a Savior, the Lord Jesus Christ, *Philippians 3:20 (ESV)*

The God's peace guards my heart & mind.

⁷ And the peace of God, which surpasses all understanding, will guard your hearts and your minds in Christ Jesus. *Philippians 4:7 (ESV)*

God supplies all my needs.

¹⁹ And my God will supply every need of yours according to his riches in glory in Christ Jesus. *Philippians 4:19 (ESV)*

I have been raised up with Christ

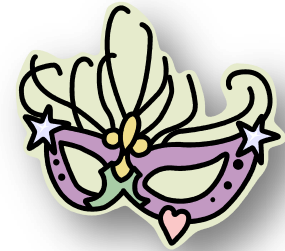
¹ If then you have been raised with Christ, seek the things that are above, where Christ is, seated at the right hand of God. *Colossians 3:1 (ESV)*

¹² Yet to all who received him, to those who believed in his name, he gave the right to become children of God-- John 1:12 (NIV)

I am a branch of the True Vine.

¹ I am the true vine, and my Father is the vinedresser. ⁵ I am the vine; you are the branches. Whoever abides in me and I in him, he it is that bears much fruit, for apart from me you can do nothing. John 15:1-5 (ESV)

I am a friend of Jesus.

¹⁵ No longer do I call you servants, for the servant does not know what his master is doing; but I have called you friends, for all that I have heard from my Father I have made known to you. John 15:15 (ESV)

I have been justified and redeemed.

²⁴ Yet now God in his gracious kindness declares us not guilty. He has done this through Christ Jesus, who has freed us by taking away our sins. Romans 3:24 (NLT)

My old self was crucified with Christ, and I am no longer a slave to sin.

⁶ For we know that our old self was crucified with him so that the body of sin might be done away with, that we should no longer be slaves to sin-- Romans 6:6 (NIV)

I will not be condemned by God.

¹ So now there is no condemnation for those who belong to Christ Jesus. Romans 8:1 (NLT)

I have been set free from the law of sin and death.

² For the power of the life-giving Spirit has freed you through Christ Jesus from

the power of sin that leads to death.

Romans 8:2 (NLT)

As a child of God, I am a fellow heir with Christ.

¹⁷ Now if we are children, then we are heirs--heirs of God and co-heirs with Christ, if indeed we share in his sufferings in order that we may also share in his glory. Romans 8:17 (NIV)

I have been accepted by Christ.

⁷ Accept one another, then, just as Christ accepted you, in order to bring praise to God. Romans 15:7 (NIV)

I have been called to be a saint.

² To the church of God that is in Corinth, to those sanctified in Christ Jesus, called to be saints together with all those who in every place call upon the name of our Lord Jesus Christ, both their Lord and ours: 1 Corinthians 1:2 (ESV)

My body is a temple of the Holy Spirit.

¹⁶ Do you not know that you are God's temple and that God's Spirit dwells in you? 1 Corinthians 3:16 (ESV)

¹⁹ Or do you not know that your body is a temple of the Holy Spirit within you, whom you have from God? You are not your own, 1 Corinthians 6:19 (ESV)

I am joined to the Lord and am one spirit with Him.

¹⁷ But he who is joined to the Lord becomes one spirit with him. 1 Corinthians 6:17 (ESV)

The hardening of my mind has been removed in Christ.

¹⁴ But their minds were hardened. For to this day, when they read the old covenant, that same veil remains unlifted, because only through Christ is it taken away. 2 Corinthians 3:14 (ESV)

I am a new creation in Christ.

¹⁷ Therefore, if anyone is in Christ, he is a new creation. The old has passed away; behold, the new has come. 2 Corinthians 5:17 (ESV)

I have become the righteousness of God in Christ.

²¹ For our sake he made him to be sin who knew no sin, so that in him we might become the righteousness of God. 2 Corinthians 5:21 (ESV)

I have been made one with all who are in Christ Jesus.

²⁸ There is neither Jew nor Greek, there is neither slave nor free, there is neither male nor female, for you are all one in Christ Jesus. Galatians 3:28 (ESV)

I am no longer a slave but a child & heir.

⁷ So you are no longer a slave, but a son, and if a son, then an heir through God. Galatians 4:7 (ESV)

I have been set free in Christ

¹ For freedom Christ has set us free; stand firm therefore, and do not submit again to a yoke of slavery. Galatians 5:1 (ESV)
